By car

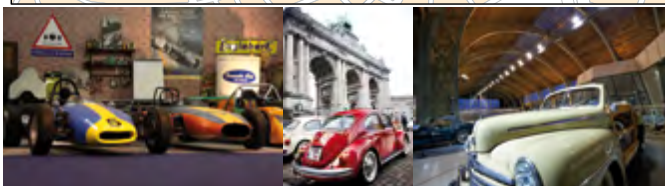
Coming from Maarschalk Montgomeryplein/Square Maréchal Montgomery:

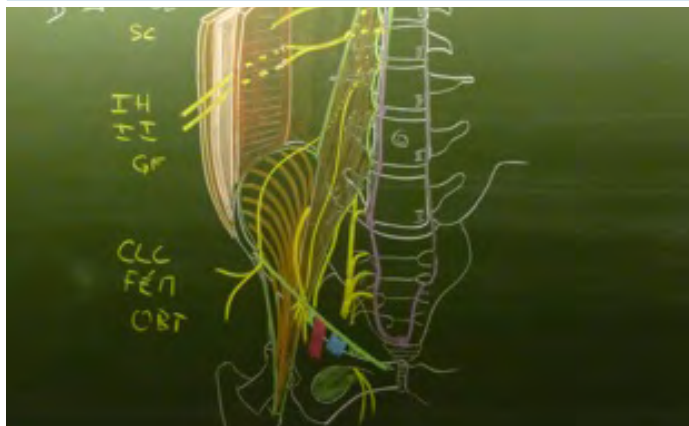
